The second stage of the ESO, pH buffering, ensures your water does not become too acidic. The final stage of the ESO is the company's proven Fibredyne filtration process. This filter media is manufactured using the most advanced activated carbon wet molding technology allowing for a higher mass of carbon to reduce particulates, chlorine, taste and odor that can taint the flavor and quality of espresso.
